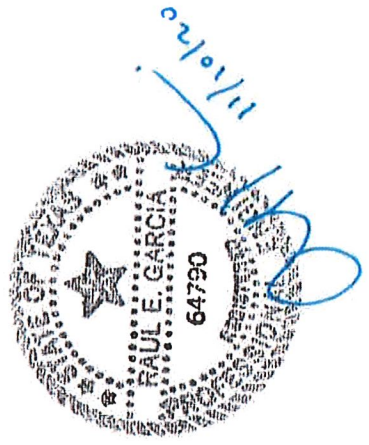

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF THE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS, CALLING A RUN-OFF ELECTION FOR THE OFFICES OF MAYOR, , ESTABLISHING THE DATES AND TIMES OF EARLY VOTING FOR SUCH ELECTION; ESTABLISHING A DATE FOR A RUNOFF ELECTION, IF REQUIRED; AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH CAMERON COUNTY TO FURNISH ELECTION SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT; AND APPOINTING ELECTION JUDGES, ALTERNATE ELECTION JUDGES, AN EARLY VOTING CLERK, AND GENERAL CUSTODIAN OF THE ELECTION MATERIALS.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Election Code of the State of Texas and the Rio Hondo Type A City, it is provided that there shall be held in each municipality in the State of Texas, a general election for the purpose of electing officials of said municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Rio Hondo City Commission has determined that a contract with the Cameron County Elections Administration for election services and equipment is in the best interest of the City of Rio Hondo.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

The City Commission of the City of Rio Hondo, Texas, at a Special meeting held this date, does hereby order an election of officers for the City of Rio Hondo, Texas, to be held on the December 19 2020, for the purpose of electing Mayor who shall serve for a period of three (3) years or until their successors have been duly qualified. The candidate receiving a majority of the votes cast for Mayor shall be declared elected to such offices.

SECTION 2.

The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute a contract with the Cameron County Elections Administrator for the purpose of having Cameron County furnish all or any portion of the election services and equipment needed by the City to conduct the election. The contract document and election services provided therein shall conform to Chapter 3 1, Subchapter D, of the Texas Election Code and other applicable statutes and laws.

SECTION 3.

The election services contract shall provide (a) all election supplies and equipment to be used for early voting by personal appearance and on election day, (b) notification and training for election judges and clerks, (c) an estimate and final payment terms for the election services provided, (d) agreements for early voting equipment and voting machine rental, and (e) other procedures to conduct the election.

SECTION 4.

Combined ballots may be utilized containing all of the offices and propositions to be voted on at each polling place, provided that no voter shall be given a ballot or permitted to vote for any office or proposition on which the voter is ineligible to vote. Returns may be made on forms, which are individual or combined, and the Cameron County Elections Administrator shall be designated as the custodian of the combined records.

SECTION 5.

Remi Garza, Cameron County Elections Administrator, 1050 E. Madison Street, Brownville, Texas 78520, is hereby appointed as Early Voting Clerk and General Custodian of the Election Materials until the time period required by law has lapsed. Furthermore, the Cameron County Elections Administrator is authorized to contact Election Judges and Alternate Judges who are hereby appointed as identified in Exhibit B of the Joint Election Agreement, attached hereto.

SECTION 6.

Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted at Rio Hondo City Hall Civic Center, Rio Hondo Texas 78583 during the hours and dates as identified in Exhibit A of the Joint Election Agreement, attached hereto.

SECTION 7.

All resident, qualified voters, determined by the laws of the State of Texas, ordinances of the City of Rio Hondo shall be qualified to vote at such election. Voting on Election Day, December 19, 2020, shall be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the following locations and opened to all voters in Cameron County:

Rio Hondo Civic Center

121 North Arroyo, Rio Hondo, TX

SECTION 8.

Applications for candidacy to the offices of Mayor, has closed.

SECTION 9.

The results of the election shall be certified, canvassed, and returned in the form and manner prescribed by the laws of the State of Texas and ordinances of the City of Rio Hondo.

SECTION 10.

The notice of the election hereby ordered and called shall be promulgated, published and posted in keeping with the laws of the State of Texas, and the Charter and ordinances of the City of Rio Hondo.

SECTION 11.

The City Manager and the City Secretary, in consultation with the City Attorney, are hereby authorized and directed to take any and all actions necessary to comply with the provisions of Federal and State law in carrying out and conducting the election, whether or not expressly authorized herein.



Subject: How to read the Canvass Reports and Report Partial Precincts for your jurisdiction

As this was joint election the canvass reports look a little different than what you might expect to see and may require some adjustments when you present the numbers to your jurisdictions.

This is concerning the Total Votes Cast line at the top of the report in the Summary Report and the Individual Precinct Reports the Precinct by Precinct Section.

This contains total votes cast for the Precincts that cover your jurisdictions. It does not compensate for partial precincts. Meaning it is including the entire precinct and not just the areas within the precinct that contains your individual jurisdiction lines. With regard to this, each precinct had specific styles and only those that applied to your jurisdictions are included in what each individual race. The actual total ballots cast for each precinct for your jurisdiction, specifically the partial precincts, can be calculated by adding all the votes cast in an individual race, including the Total votes for candidates, the over votes and the under votes. That will give you the total ballots cast. If you do that for each race you will find that the all should equal the same number of ballot cast in each race.

As you prepare to present your canvass you should update the Partial Precincts total ballots cast to reflect that calculation. I apologize that we were not able to make those adjustments but as this was a joint election the total ballots cast was tied to the Precinct itself.

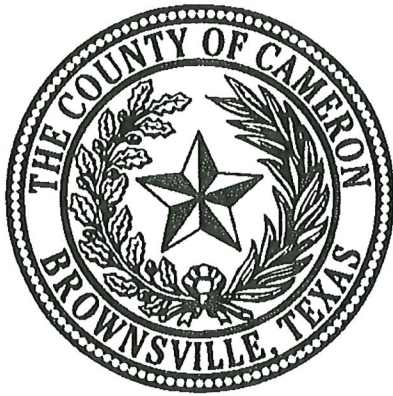

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
