A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS, CAMERON COUNTY TEXAS, AUTHORIZING CITY REPRESENTATIVES IN MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City Commission the City of Rio Hondo desires to develop a viable community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low-to-moderate income; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of City of Rio Hondo to participate in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program and to fund \$100,000 dollars as a match income and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Rio Hondo is committed to compliance with federal, state, and program rules, including the current TxCDBG Project Implementation Manual; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF RIO HONDO, TEXAS:

That the City Commission directs and designates the following to act in all matters in connection with any grant application and the County's participation in the Texas Community


Development Block Grant Program:

- The [Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, City Manager, shall serve as the City's

Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to

- execute a grant application and any subsequent contractual documents,
 - certify environmental review documents between the Texas Department of Agriculture and the City, and
 - certify the Payment Request form and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs, and to be assigned the role of Authorized Official in the TDA-GO grant management system.
- In addition to the above designated officials, should any grant be funded the Mayor and City Manager, is authorized to
 - certify the Payment Request form and/or other forms required for requesting funds to reimburse project costs,
 - prepare and submit other financial documentation and to be assigned the role of Project Director or Payment Processor in the TDA-GO grant management system.
